Where

Chichester Northgate (Theatre) car park. Meet at 17:00 just outside the south west (underpass) gate to the Northgate (Theatre) car park. If you can't get there until a bit later then call my mobile when you arrive. The number will be on your booking acknowledgement.

What's is all about?

The Sloe Fair is a travelling funfair that is held annually in Chichester. Traditionally it is on 20 October but this year it is on MONDAY 21 October at Northgate car park in Chichester. The fair was first held in 1107 or 1108 after King Henry I of the Kingdom of England granted Ralph de Luffa, Bishop of Chichester, the right to hold a fair.

The modern Sloe Fair is organized by the Showmen's Guild of Great Britain and the main attractions are mechanical fairground rides.

This provides excellent opportunities for low light, action and street photography.



The entire car park is taken up by the fair so you would need to park in town or nearby roads then walk to the fair. It's free to get in and there's plenty of space to set up tripods, just be wary of making a trip hazard and take all normal precautions at a public event. Lots of fast and colourful rides to photograph.

I've attached a couple of photos that I took at a previous Fair when I had a nice sunset as a backdrop! The fair runs all day until late, but I expect most people will want to take photos as it's starting to get dark. Oct 21 sunset is 17:59

and the sky will have gone from blue to black within an hour.

Afterwards we could pop to the George & Dragon in North Street for a refreshing drink.
